



You can get your child ready to read.

FROM YOUR OWN KITCHEN TABLE • TEN MINUTES A DAY

You already read to your child. This is the ten minutes that go underneath it. You do not need to be a reading teacher. Here is who does what.

1 We

assess your child, set the goals, and send a new Skill and Practice Game every week.

2 You

play it with your child for ten minutes a day. No prep, no planning, nothing to buy.

3 Your child

practices the sound skills that reading is built on, and starts school ready.

No technology for your child. The only screen is the short weekly video you watch.

Try one tonight: I Spy Sounds *No prep. Works anywhere.*

1 Pick something you can both see.

Say “I spy something that starts with /b/.” Say the sound, not the letter name.

2 Let your child guess.

Ball, book, banana. Any answer that starts with that sound is right.

3 Then swap.

Your child spies, you guess. Getting it wrong on purpose is half the fun.

Your goal: five to ten minutes, five or six times this week.

Why this works: *Before a child can match a letter to a sound, they have to hear it. This game builds that.*
